**O14/24.1** Hallburn Wind Farm Grant Scheme – Council was updated by Cllr Moore, who confirmed that the next meeting would be on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2024 and the closing

date for applications was 17<sup>th</sup> July 2024

**014/24.2 Bus Shelter** – Cllr McGarr reported that the shelter was now in frequent use

and there were no signs of graffiti although a notice regarding a missing cat

had been found placed in the shelter.

**Speeding –** Cllr McGarr indicated that due to lack of volunteer numbers the

idea of a Community Speedwatch Group would be placed in abeyance. A

general discussion took place around the idea of SID's (Speed Indicator Devices) and it was agreed that Highways should be consulted and the potential for a Grant request from Hallburn considered.

**Replacement Clerk / RFO** – Council had had no response from CALC for help and advice regarding the process and council would continue to seek out any volunteers who may be interested. Clerk advised that no applications had been received and after further discussion Cllrs McGarr and Moore asked to continue in the pursuit of a replacement.

Cllr. Mallinson advised that the minimum age for an individual to be considered for the role was 21.

The Clerk indicated that he would prepare the Agenda for the next meetings(s) but Council would have to provide a minute taker. The Clerk also advised that he would be in attendance at the next meeting to enable the AGAR documents to be completed.
